#### INTRODUCTION



- AIMS (Accident and Incident Management System) will be launched on 1 August 2016 at 8:00 hrs.
- 2. AIMS is part of EHS360, an integrated IT system, to assist PIs and Departments to manage safety and health holistically.
- 3. Comprises of the following functions in an user-friendly interface:
  - a) Submission of incident notification
  - b) Submission of incident assessment/investigation report
  - c) Approval of incident investigation report


- No major change to existing accident/incident reporting & investigation process
